Maryland Air National Guard Logs 10,000 Accident-Free Hours In U.S. Air Force's Newest C-130J

What: The Maryland Air National Guard's 135th Airlift Group of the 175th Wing has surpassed 10,000 flying hours in the U.S. Air Force's newest cargo aircraft, the C-130J Hercules.
